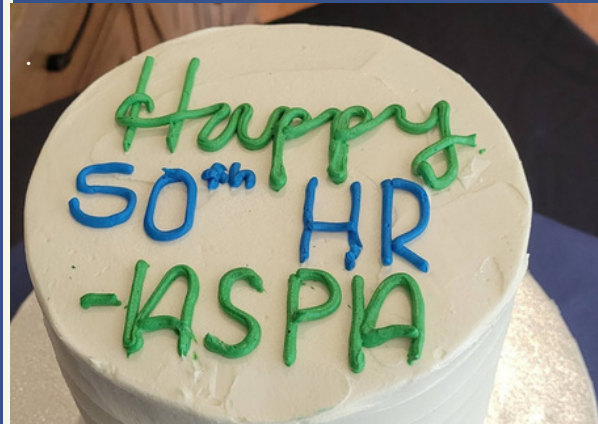

We kicked off the year with our fall luncheon at the Founder's Inn with the dynamic speaker, Michelle Ellis Young, Executive Director of the YWCA of South Hampton Roads. Ms. Ellis Young highlighted the important role the YWCA of South Hampton Roads has played for over 100 years in our community, assisting victims of domestic violence and many other areas.

In December we held a virtual panel discussion titled "Building Resilient Communities in Virginia. Our three engaging speakers were Lacy Shirey, Executive Director of the Elizabeth River Project, Karen Firehock, Executive Director of the Green Infrastructure Center, and Trang Le, Assistant Research Professor at the Institute for Coastal Adaptation and Resilience (ICAR).
